Restrictions in Broward County

# Currently Closed or Limited by Governor

- Closed:
  - Bars (closed by DBPR)
  - Night clubs
- 50% capacity limitations:
  - Indoor dining at restaurants
  - Entertainment businesses
- State approval required to reopen:
  - Pari-mutuel facilities
  - Amusement Parks
  - Vacation rentals

# Currently Closed or Limited by Broward

- Closed:
  - Bars, pubs, breweries, except for off-site food/alcohol
  - Night clubs, cocktail lounges, hookah bars, billiards halls/clubs, and cabarets
  - Banquet halls (except for classroom/meeting function space)
  - Most adult entertainment establishments
  - Short-term vacation rentals without on-site management/staffing 24/7 for check-in prior to 8/20 (limited exceptions)
  - Hot tubs (public or community)
- 50% capacity limitations:
  - Indoor dining at restaurants
  - Retail
  - Museums
  - Indoor amusement facilities
  - Housing development amenities
  - Commercial gyms and fitness centers
  - Pools & pool decks

# Currently Closed or Limited by Broward

- Park Restrictions Overview:
  - Group size limited to 10 persons (other than organized sports by established leagues/programs)
  - Courts limited to singles/doubles/horse play
- Beach Restrictions Overview:
  - Group size limited to 10 persons
  - No organized sports
  - Buildings (other than restrooms) and social gathering locations (playgrounds, etc.) closed
  - Limited hours: sunrise to sunset

# Additional Limitations

- Curfew:
  - Daily curfew from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. (with limited exceptions)
  - Expires August 1
- Restaurants:
  - Food/beverage may only be consumed or ordered for on-site consumption while patron is seated at the assigned table
  - No onsite consumption of food or beverage between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
  - Party size limited to 6 persons (10 if all from same household)

# Facial Coverings Required

- Whenever outside your home and social distancing cannot be maintained, including at parks, beaches, and pools
- At all establishments (other than amenities such as parks and beaches) regardless of social distancing
- While working at any establishment regardless of social distancing
- While in any common area of a housing development regardless of social distancing

# Facial Coverings Exceptions

- Children under 2 or children in daycare
- While eating, drinking, or receiving a service that prevents wearing a facial covering
- Disability or medical condition (establishments may forbid entry under certain circumstances)
- Public health and safety personnel
- Strenuous activity/exercise and socially distant (except gyms, where required at all times)
- Working at an establishment (other than retail, restaurant, indoor amusement facility, or gym/fitness center) with nobody else within 6' who is not a member of your household, or while alone in the room

# Prohibited Gatherings

- Private gatherings on residential property of more than 10 people (excluding the residents and their parents and minor children)
- All gatherings of more than 10 people unless specifically excepted. Exceptions include:
  - Regular business of the establishment (grocery stores, religious services, etc.)
  - Private gatherings of limited size (see above)
  - Gatherings expressly permitted by an applicable order (organized sports, etc.)
